

THE MIDWEST DIVISION I.T. TOUR 2010 Series Regulations

1. The Midwest Division I.T. Tour shall comprise all the races conducted as Improved Touring category special events, under Restricted Regional sanction, on dates upon which a regularly scheduled MiDiv National race is held.
2. Classes shall be those defined in the GCR for the Improved Touring category plus ITE and IT7 as set out in the Mid-Am Regulations.
3. All drivers who are members of a Region in the Midwest Division are eligible.
4. Races shall be scheduled for at least 15 minutes duration or at least 20 miles.
5. Entry forms should identify the IT race scheduled as part of a National Race program as a "MiDiv I.T. Tour Race."
6. Only one I.T. Tour race shall be scheduled on a weekend, unless a Double National is sanctioned in which case two I.T. Tour races may be scheduled.
7. Points will be scored according to GCR 3.9.1.B Point Awards and GCR 3.9.1.C Ties, except that drivers whose regions of membership are not in the Midwest Division will not be considered in the scoring. (The highest placing MiDiv driver gets winner's points, etc.)
8. A driver's best finishes in 60% of the scheduled races (rounded up to the next whole number) will count. Out-of-division races will not count.
9. Points will be kept along with MiDiv National Points, under a separate heading for The Midwest Division I.T. Tour.
10. Series championship awards will be presented to the top three drivers in each class. A driver must start at least 30% of the scheduled I.T. Tour races (rounded up to the next whole number) to qualify for awards.
11. Trophy Fund assessments for races in The Midwest Division I.T. Tour shall be the same as that for a Mid-Am Race.
